JAMSHEDPUR PLAYS GOLF LEAGUE! [JGL] - IV 2021

➤ The JGL is based on the likes of the Indian Premier League for cricket, a hot favourite among our 'one sport' crazy nation. Through the JPL, Golfers experience thrill, competition, excitement in this event.

The excitement begins a few months before the actual start of the event. Team formation is a major job handled by the team Captains with much aplomb, selecting members for their teams keeping in mind the quality of their game, their handicaps, compatibility, and their ability to bear the pressures associated with the event. The golf course is a hub of activity with teams regularly practicing,

assessing partnerships, assessing team members and, in the process, of course, providing livelihood to a large number of caddies.

The JGL began on Sat, 23rd Jan. 2021 with a match play event between the teams divided into two pools. Each team consists of 13 players, with a maximum of two ladies, and a minimum of one senior golfer (60 years plus). The fixtures are held every weekend with each team fielding ten players in groups of 2 each thus making 5 pairs.

This year 11 teams were in the fray. The season took off after a lot of preparation and strategic team meetings. In the golf course a huge board radiates team names like birdie battalion, phoenix, Yellow Eagles and such like and reflects their points. Flags depicting the logo of each team are flying high. The game continues.....

Rtn. Virpi Honkala from Helsinki, Finland

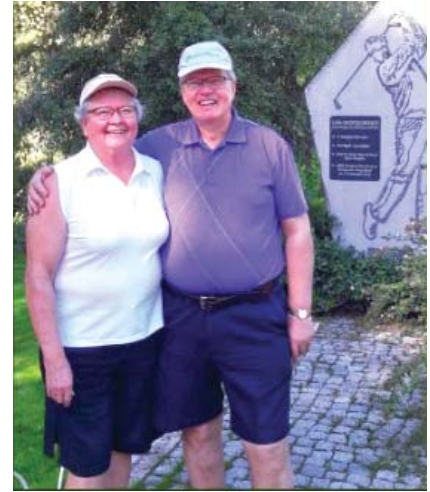

GREAT CHIPPING FROM THE FRINGE!

Brooks Koepka chips in for eagle on 17th to take one shot lead.

[Event: PGA Tour Feb 4-7, 2021, Phoenix Open]

From where Koepka found himself after his drive on fateful 17th, there was a large hump between him and hole. From this spot, he had a difficult pitch if he wanted to get the ball close. With little green to work with, he had to strike a perfect shot to get the ball close.

Knowing that the high flop has a small margin for error, Koepka played a lower pitch shot. He chose a landing spot in the fringe near the hump, taking some heat off the ball as it approached the hole.

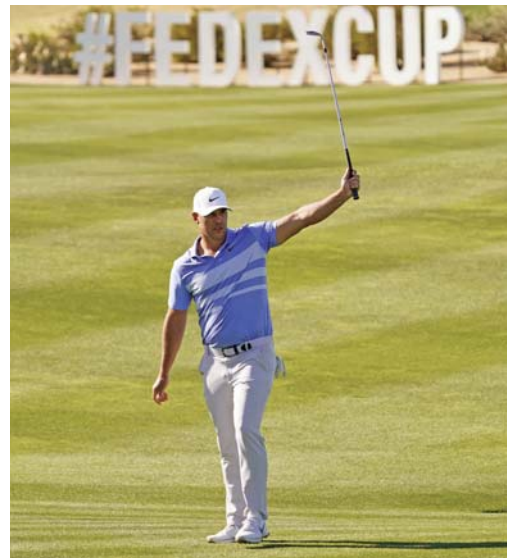
There is great learning from this shot for the recreational golfers - how to use the fringe to slow down your chips and pitches around the green.

So, guys and gals, next time you are

out practicing, start choosing a distinct spot you want the ball to land. Once you start hitting those spots with regularity, try choosing a spot on the fringe as you'll notice ball loses a lot of steam on first bounce and slows down, which can be great for you, especially if you are short sided.

It also means, when next time you face a short-sided pitch, don't go straight for the lob wedge. Instead, assess if a lower-lofted pitch that lands in the rough might be more prudent option. It's a crafty shot to have in the bag around the greens, and it is much lower risk than the flop shot!

Wishing you a good shot from the fringe!

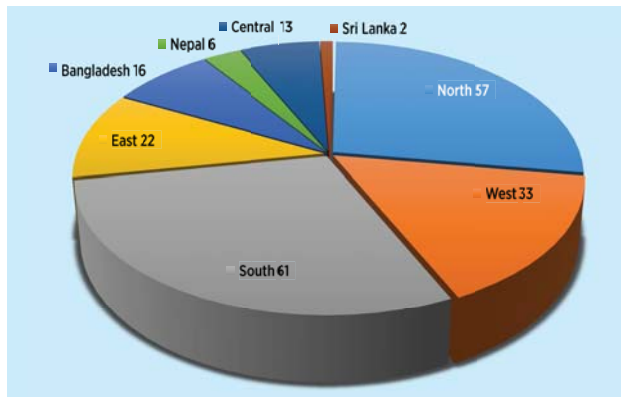

I travelled to participate in the 6th Edition of Golf Charity event of Rotary Hyderabad Deccan [RID 3150] held on 21.02.2021. It was an amazing experience to witness fund raising Golf tournament for community cause. It was well planned and well executed event for mammoth health projects initiated by Club members.

I noticed every member worked in unison with dedication and one voice. There was no attention to their status, stature and position in the society and Club. All golfers were a family. The event enabled collection of sufficient donations even in this pandemic time. This

was possible due to members' commitment, transparency and accountability. It was very inspiring to observe that over and above the general collections, one donor simply telephoned to the Event Chair urging him to match the donation only one day before the Event. And it was bingo!

SAFGR SUPPORTED EVENTS

RC Hyderabad Deccan

News brief by President Rtn. VVSN Raju of RC Hyderabad Deccan –

The RC Hyderabad Deccan has been very active in its service activities and with the support of TRF and Rotary Clubs globally. The club has executed several projects in the areas of safe water, literacy, education and health care for our local communities. The current community service projects in focus are:

“We deeply appreciate the participants and sponsors that vie to participate in our annual Rotary Golf for Charity tournament and celebrate their commitment to give with us, back to our communities.”

- Setting up of a State of art 8 bedded charitable Rotary Dialysis Centre. This is run in partnership with Red cross society at Guntur [Telangana]. The outlay was Rs 1 crore.
- Setting up of a Community Health Centre at the Gurudwara, Ameerpet having complete suite of Diagnostics and Medical Consultation at very affordable prices with an estimated cost of Rs. 50 Lakhs.

Rotary Club of Hyderabad Deccan [RCHD] is now 34 young [chartered 1988] with 100 active members from various vocations. Club efforts have impacted lives of over 20,000 school going children by providing them with safe water, classrooms and desks. Over 200,000 villagers benefitted by provision of 40 RO plants in fluorosis affected areas. In 2016, RCHD set up a Dialysis Centre at Secunderabad and a state



of art Blood Bank at Ameerpet at a total cost of over Rs. 2.0 crore in partnership with the TRF and Rotary Club of Naperville Chicago.

The Dialysis Centre, housed in the Secunderabad Gurudwara and run by the Mahavir Charitable Trust has completed over 40,000 dialysis at a charge of a mere Rs. 300 each. The Rotary Blood bank housed in Challa Hospital (Ameerpet) has collected over 40,000 units of blood for the needy. Further, Club has donated a 3-laser, 11 channel cytometer setup at and run by the Basavatarakam Indo-American Cancer Hospital & Research Institute providing free specialized diagnostic services to children from families of below the poverty line (BPL)



who are suffering from Childhood Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (ALL), commonly known as Blood Cancer.

During this pandemic the club was at the forefront serving the needy by distributing dry rations & cooked food. We had also set up a Plasma bank for collection & distribution of blood plasma in aiding the therapy for the Covid effected. By Raju, +919866446467 Email: rajurchd@gmail.com




